History of WEC South Africa

Pioneer missionary Charles T. Studd went to Congo in 1913 and founded the Heart of Africa Mission, today known as WEC International.

In 1927 his wife visited South Africa and as a result, four young people were called by God for missionary service. During the visit of another missionary from Congo in 1935 the South African Council for WEC was formed.

A permanent Sending Base came into being in 1955. A ministry started by which Christians were challenged about the needs of the unreached and candidates were trained and sent out as long term missionaries.

In spite of the system of 'separate development', WEC leadership in 1979 received permission, and with it opposition, when they became the first mission in South Africa to train and send out workers from all ethnic groups from their Headquarters in Durban.
